Installation of Exhibit in the Weston Museum Courtyard Floor

As discussed at an informal meeting on the morning of Monday 16th May, a proposal has been made to install a new exhibit in the Weston Museum in advance of the opening of See Monster on the sea front in order hopefully to help attract visitors to See Monster to visit the Museum.

Installation of exhibits would not normally require committee authority, however this exhibit for reasons of safety and stability would require being fixed into the floor at one end of the courtyard with some wooden blocks having to be temporarily removed. The exhibit being secured to the foundations and the blocks then largely replaced.

The wooden blocks are not in their original position having been previously removed and the concreted in and it is understood that the Conservation Officer at North Somerset Council has advised that she considers that this does not require Listed Building Consent.

This matter is urgent because the Museum wishes to install the exhibit by the end of June, in advance of the opening of See Monster which is due to open in July.

DECISION:

Under the Town Council's Scheme of Delegation paragraph 2 "Chairman's Action" we as Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Heritage, Arts and Culture Committee in consultation with the Town Clerk **AGREE** that a new exhibit can be installed and fixed in the Weston Museum courtyard floor as described above.
