	Jason Beale, Customer Services Manager for Development and Environment for of North Somerset Council provided the Committee with an overview of matters communicated at the Parish Workshop meeting which had been held on 14th May 2014.
	Key updates included:
	North Somerset Council's planning consultation process was now totally paperless, he thanked Weston-super-Mare Town Council for pioneering this move.
	The new website which was a one-stop-shop for planning advice and applications had now been launched, new features included 'report it' and 'contact us' forms and had been designed to enable the public submit planning applications and access relevant advice in a more efficient and cost effective manner than previously. It was noted that Planning Officers were tasked with complexity as opposed to simplicity, hence general enquires would now be handled by Customer Services staff. It was hoped that Town Councillors would share this information and encourage the public to use the service when making planning applications or requiring advice on planning matters. The benefits of the new

website would also be featured in the 'Life' magazine so as to inform members of the public across the district. As a result of Government imposed changes to the prior approval regime (April 2014) intended to speed up the planning process North Somerset Council were no longer required to consult with Town and Parish Council's but would take on board comments if received within the strict new deadlines. Discussion ensued on the Core Strategy and the impact on the districts housing allocation and strategy following a high court challenge in relation to housing numbers in Bristol. Councillor King arrived at 7.10 pm. 120.
