	A Member requested feedback on planning applications discussed at previous meetings and disabled parking bays.

All planning application decisions were available for public viewing on North Somerset Council's website. However, it was not possible due to timescales to facilitate this within monthly Planning Committee meetings as the main remit of the Committee was to consider new applications.

# 176. Planning Applications and Other Planning Matters Submitted to the Town Council for Consideration

The Committee considered applications in respect of the weekly lists for  $21^{st}$  &  $28^{th}$  September and  $5^{th}$  &  $12^{th}$  October 2015.

Discussion ensued on Weston-super-Mare Town Council Policy and North Somerset Council Policy in relation to one-bedroomed flats in Central Ward and discouraging changes of use from retail to residential in established shopping areas.

The Assistant Town Clerk advised that she would bring current Town Council planning polices to the next meeting in order that the Committee could deliberate further and potentially make recommendations/amendments to full Council.

#### **RESOLVED:**

a) That North Somerset Council's Policy status be established in relation to one bedroom flats in the Town Centre.

The Assistant Town Clerk and Chairman would meet to discuss current planning policy and should revisions be felt necessary they would be put forward to the Town Clerk for inclusion in the new Town Council Strategy for 2016-2020 which was currently being determined by Group Leaders prior to Town Council approval in January 2016. That the comments contained in Appendix A be forwarded to North Somerset Council. The Chairman reiterated his requests at previous meetings for Councillors to undertake preliminary notes of objections to planning applications direct from North Somerset Council's website in their own particular wards prior to meetings and bring comments with them to Committee in order to reduce the amount of debate into so many planning applications and trim meeting times.
