# Welcome by the Mayor of Weston-super-Mare, Councillor Jos Holder

The Mayor welcomed the Deputy Lord Lieutenant of Somerset, distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen and Councillors to the Mayor Making Ceremony and Annual Meeting of the Town Council.

In recognition and thanks for their services throughout her terms of office, the Mayor presented her retiring Chaplain Rev. Andrew Alden, retiring Deputy Chaplain Rev. Steven Christian, and retiring Cadet A. Poyser with a Town Council Shield and the Mayoress with a bouquet of flowers.

Preceded by the Mace and Macebearer, the retiring Mayor (Councillor Jos Holder), and Mayoress (Councillor Roz Willis), the Town Clerk (Malcolm Nicholson) and the retiring Mayor's Chaplain (Rev. Andrew Alden) adjourned from the meeting, returning to the Council Chamber when robing had been completed.

The Mayor, Councillor Michael Lyall, took his seat.

The Mayor, at the request of the Town Clerk proceeded to read out the Declaration of Acceptance of Office of Mayor of Weston-super-Mare for the year 2018/19, signing the document and returning thanks for his election to office.

The Mayor thanked Councillor Gibbons for proposing and Councillor Webb for seconding that he be elected Mayor.

The Mayor invited Councillor Peter Crew to propose and Councillor Michal Kus to seconda vote of thanks to the retiring Mayor and Mayoress.

The Mayor invited the retiring Mayor and Mayoress of Weston-super-Mare to come forward and to accept the Town Council commemorative shields to mark the Town Council's appreciation of their services during their term of office 2017/18
